



Construction of upgrades and improvements to the sanitary sewer collection system, located in the Borough of Wenonah, County of Gloucester, State of New Jersey, in the amount of \$821,205.00, were financed by the New Jersey Water Bank (NJWB). The NJWB is a State Revolving Fund program jointly administered by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) and the New Jersey Infrastructure Bank (Infrastructure Bank) and uses a combination of funds provided by the United States Environmental Protection Agency, the DEP, and the Infrastructure Bank to provide very low interest loans to borrowers for environmental infrastructure projects.

This project will provide water quality benefits by minimizing wastewater exfiltration into the environment, minimizing infiltration of ground water into the collection system, and providing improved reliability of the collection system for residents and businesses in the Borough of Wenonah.

State Revolving Fund programs around the nation provide states and communities the resources necessary to maintain and improve the infrastructure protecting our valuable water resources nationwide.
