The Wenonah Volunteer Fire Company has been faithfully serving the Borough of Wenonah and assisting our neighboring communities for 114 years. The year 2022 continued the ongoing recovery from the devastating 2021 tornado event throughout our town. This year the company was in service 221 times, including 160 dispatched assignments, 46 drills, and 15 community service events. I wish to emphasize that those numbers reflect official times in service. They do not account for the administrative hours, firehouse maintenance, washing and maintaining the trucks, etc. all of which are extra hours our members contribute to keep the fire company running efficiently and our building well cared for.

Though there were a few fires that caused some property damage to homes in Wenonah, including a small kitchen fire and a dryer fire, I am pleased to report there were no injuries sustained and only minimal damage to homes. Those outcomes are in no small part due to the quick and skilled service of your Wenonah volunteers. Our members were able to apply that same quick and skilled response to assist a number of our neighboring communities with all-hands dwelling/building fires this year including Deptford Township, Mantua Township, and the City of Woodbury. We continue our strategic mutual-aid partnership with the Borough of Woodbury Heights to ensure an adequate response to any emergencies in either town. The line officers and I updated our mutual aid plans this year to provide a better strategy not only for staffing a fire, but also to provide our members with necessary backup for their own protection. This included adding Ladder 2816 from Pitman Fire Co. #1 to the initial response on any structure fire dispatch in the Borough.

We sincerely thank the residents of Wenonah for your support both in encouragement and financially through our fundraisers. The fire company was the recipient this year of a very generous gift in memory of Firefighter James Grimm, who served over half a century ago. His family made a donation in his memory which allowed us to purchase new battery operated ventilation fans, combustible gas meters, and a multi-gas meter. These tools help not only in firefighting, but also in the ever-increasing number of fumes/odor of gas responses to which we respond.

It was exciting to resume a normal training schedule after the effects of COVID and the tornado. A major focus this year was Squad Company operations, especially in the area of Motor Vehicle Crash response. We also partnered with Mantua Township to train on forcible entry, water tender operations, and water supply operations. We completed our required live fire training with Woodbury Heights. Firefighter Kevin Meeks completed his driver/pump operator training and earned the rank of Engineer. His son, Andrew, graduated from GCIT in the Fire Science program and successfully completed his Firefighter I certification.


I am indebted to my line officers, Derek and Ryan, for their assistance in the operations of the fire company. President Sole and the Executive Officers should also be commended for their tireless work in keeping the corporation running, organizing fundraisers, and maintaining the firehouse. Chief Sole and Firefighter Graves must also be applauded for their work this year in communicating the many new benefits through the State Firemen's Association to all of our living life members. Our residents should also know there are more sacrifices made behind the scenes. All of our

members are grateful for the love, support, and patience of our spouses, families, and significant others who have to deal with our absence at sometimes very inconvenient times.

I also wish to thank OEM Coordinator Rich Black for his assistance through the Wenonah Office of Emergency Management. Chief Black provides help throughout the year on various issues of public concern in the Borough. He coordinates with the County and State Emergency Management officials to ensure Wenonah always has what it needs. Thanks to Karen and the Borough staff, and Brian and the Public Works Department for their help throughout the year. We have a strong working relationship with the Mantua Police Department, their help is always appreciated. Lastly, on behalf of our membership I want to thank Mayor Dominy for his help and support of the Fire Company during his terms on Council and in the Mayor's seat.

I am pleased to report that all Borough owned equipment, including the 2018 Spartan Pumper and 2006 E-One Rescue Pumper, are in excellent working condition and current on all the required certifications and maintenance schedules.

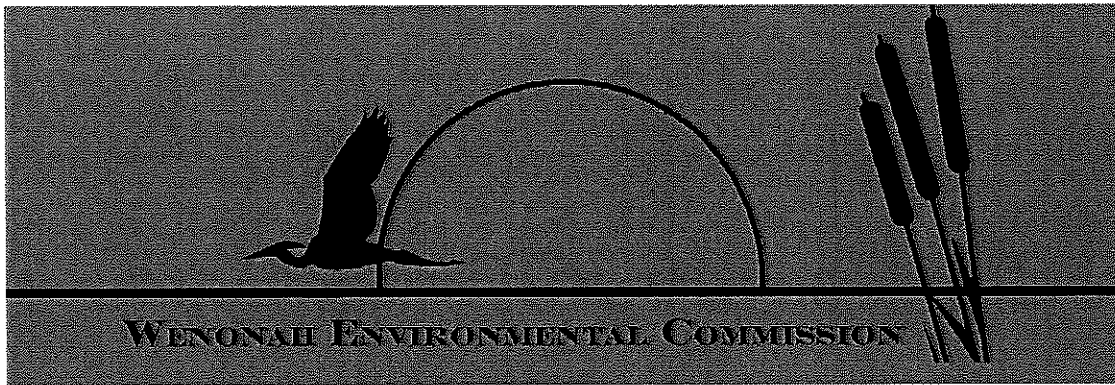

Dear Mayor and Members of Council:

This letter will serve to summarize the accomplishments of the Environmental Commission during calendar year 2022:

- Our major project this year addressed the Bog Walk, a deteriorating 120-foot wooden boardwalk across a marsh near South Marion Avenue. Despite the difficult work environment, our team was able to completely rebuild the structure in a couple of weeks with only a few falls in the mud. Trail users can now enjoy a 28" wide walking surface that is 8" higher and less likely to be flooded. This \$4,000 project was funded with a combination of private donations and our annual budget.
 - We continued tomado recovery efforts by planting trees and shrubs along the Glen Trail near West Cedar Street. These plantings will help distinguish the trail from the relatively flat and open neighboring property. We also reinstalled the sitting bench that had been uprooted during the storm.
 - In October, we and the Gloucester County Nature Club held the eighth edition of the Mad Hatter's Tree Party, attracting people of all ages to Eldridge Trail to learn about the importance of trees to the health of our local ecosystem.
 - For the tenth year in a row, we engaged a professional firm to chemically treat Comey's Lake and Dilks' Pond against unsightly duckweed and algae plants during the summer months.
 - We continued a wide variety of regular maintenance tasks, including: picking up trash, painting over graffiti, cutting fallen trees, filling in sinkholes, protecting trees against beavers, and opening blocked waterways. Some larger trash we picked up this year included a 6-foot folding table, a basketball hoop, 15 shipping pallets, and a
-

full-size recliner chair. Also we dismantled two "forts" this year, one created by younger children and a much more sophisticated dugout built by a teenager.

- We held three educational hikes: one with Girl Scouts, one with Gateway AP science students, and one as part of the Wenonah Lake Swimming Program. Another group of Gateway students spread mulch on the Camel's Back Loop Trail as a service project.
- We sponsored one formal work party, held two public hikes, and fielded teams for both Clean Communities Days. We also presented environmental awards to two graduating 6th graders.

In 2023, the Commission will continue to keep the 121-acre "Ring of Green" healthy and accessible for all to enjoy.

Wenonah Shade Tree Commission

2022 was a year of tree renewal

As the STC closes out 2022 it is appropriate to look back on the community's response to the impact of the 9/1/21 tornado on tree life in Wenonah. Thanks to the leadership of Mayor Dominy and the creation of the Wenonah Park Restoration Committee (WPRC) a group of volunteers were appointed to formulate a recovery plan for the park.

Thanks to the appointment of Jack Sheppard Jr. as the committee Chair and members of varying community volunteer groups, by early spring 2022 the park's recovery began. Starting with a complete park cleanup in March by resident volunteers a clean slate for plantings was revealed. With the help of Joe Palimeno-Ledden Palimino Landscaping and Bill Exley of Exley's Nursery both labor and tree donations were offered. Platt's Nursery donated additional trees while many Wenonah families and friends donated money for tree purchases in honor of loved ones. TimberCut Tree Service provided complimentary removals along the RR tracks. The key to the financing of the park restoration was the efforts of Sarah Harbold in creating a Go Fund Me Account where the public (**292 donations**) donated funds for both the park, street and conservation area tree plantings. As of this writing the fund has reached a goal of \$55,000. Major tree removals and purchases, grounds repairs and equipment purchases were made possible by this fund.

In March 2022 the WPRC began purchases of nursery grade trees of varying species. Deciduous and flowering trees (maples ,oak, cherry, plum, dogwood, london plane, ginko, lilac, crab apple, magnolia and hornbeam) and conifers (lacebark pine, Serbian Spruce, white pines, arborvitae and cedar) along with holly and winterberry shrubs. During March, April, August and September trees were planted, watered and mulched by a team of volunteers from private companies and countless community volunteers. Wenonah Public Works spent countless hours managing tree storage, transport and plantings both in the Park and all over town. Over 80 trees and shrubs were planted in the Park and along the RR tracks on S. East Ave. In the fall we were all given the blessing of colors as the sugar maples and oak with all their brothers and sister trees burst into sight. Two Wenonah Women's Club projects in the park have added further character to the landscape.

During 2022 the STC planted street trees donated by AC Electric and another 49 trees as part of our annual tree replenishment program. Over 500 volunteer hours were contributed by members in 2022. Added to the many trees donated by Exley's and planted in clear zones throughout the Boro the total town/Park tree plantings reached over **250** trees. As fall approached the STC, DPW and Go Fund Me Account coordinated a tornado damaged tree removal program in the NE and SW quadrants of town. As trees were removed we began a replanting effort. Both removals and replanting will occur throughout 2023.

The keys to all the above accomplishments have been the coordination of Wenonah Boro staff and Council, private industry contributions, family and friends donations and endless hours of Wenonah resident volunteers and organizations. As a community we have so much to be grateful for and proud of – most importantly one another.

Report to Borough Council 1.5.23

In spite of the ups and downs of life in our "Tripledemic" world, the Wenonah Public Library provides materials and services to the residents of Wenonah at a slowly increasing rate. We participate in the LOGIN consortium, which shares materials from municipal, county, and academic libraries throughout Gloucester, Cumberland, and Salem counties. In 2022, we circulated 4335 actual physical items, and provided 2800 digital interactions, which includes eBooks, Audiobooks, Movies, TV shows, Comics and Music downloads. The digital connections available through the South Jersey Download Center hosting Overdrive and Libby, Ebscohost, and hoopla are made possible by agreements with municipally funded Wenonah Public Library. Make sure your library card is up to date to take advantage of these services!

This year, the library board of trustees worked toward maintaining and improving the library facility by contracting to have new lighting and ceiling fans installed on the main floor of the library, investigating repairs to the leaded glass windows, and masonry structure, replacing the window shades, and maintaining the beautiful antique library furnishings. Those bees that moved into our roof last year decided to find another home without our planned intervention being done. We are keeping a close watch on our 95 year old slate roof for any sign of needed repairs or busy bees.

The staff at Wenonah Library, small but mighty, answer questions, search out and acquire materials from all over the LOGIN library consortium and beyond, and make every effort to maintain an atmosphere that is comfortable and quiet for students, their tutors and those working remotely. Toddler Time at 10:00 AM each Wednesday gives our youngest residents the opportunity to learn to love reading. The students from Wenonah School have recently taken field trips to make sure they are familiar with everything the library has to offer, including our connection to the North Pole. Over 100 letters to Santa were answered by that diligent elf we know. The children of Wenonah participated in the Summer Reading Program, Oceans of Possibilities, which included a visit from some sea creatures from Adventure Aquarium. The library offers passes to both the Museum of the American Revolution in Philadelphia and the Brandywine Museum of Art in Chadds Ford, Pa. For those interested in learning a new language, we offer Mango Languages Instruction through the link on our webpage, www.wenonahlibrary.com.

Our volunteers make it possible to offer fun extras, like new stories in StoryWalk around the library grounds and park. Used book sales happen twice a year on Community Yard Sale Day and on the library lawn during the Fall Festival. Technology help is available every Thursday evening to help patrons use all kinds of devices. Students preparing for PSAT/ SAT and ACT tests can prepare with free sessions on test taking offered before each test date in Spring and Fall. Important tasks like reviewing and updating the library collection are made possible with the help of volunteers, as well. Thank you volunteers!

In 2022, the Friends of Wenonah Library have begun planning activities to educate and entertain our patrons. This energetic group of volunteers has a real knack for decorating and some really great ideas. Spooky Story Night was back big time this year! So many kids participated that we split the group in two. We had music, fun, games, prizes, and apple cider doughnuts! The Holiday Open House in December was delightful. Hot chocolate and cookies were enjoyed while listening to the musical talent from Gateway High School. There is talk of author visits, book clubs and so many other fun events throughout 2023. All are welcome to join the Friends of Wenonah Library, (FOWL?)

Whereas, on September 1st, 2021, the southwestern corner of New Jersey was struck by an EF3 Tornado with winds up to 150 mph, causing unprecedented damage to hundreds of homes throughout our town, damage to our public spaces, the destruction of much of the Borough's power grid, and significant damage to the trees in Wenonah Park and throughout our community; and

Whereas, resident Sarah Harbold met with Mayor and Council, seeking to establish a fundraising method through which the Borough could receive monetary donations in support of replacing the significant loss of trees within Wenonah Park and in the Borough's "Clear Zone"; and

Whereas, Sarah Harbold created a Go Fund Me account entitled the "Wenonah Planting Fund" through which she solicited and raised more than \$54,000 since its establishment in November 2021; and

Whereas, Sarah Harbold subsequently coordinated with the Shade Tree Commission, Mayor, and Borough Council to use funds raised to support the purchase of new trees for Wenonah Park and the removal of tornado-damaged trees throughout the "Clear Zone"; and

Whereas, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Wenonah wish to acknowledge Sarah Harbold for her generous endeavors through volunteerism that have so benefited our community;

Therefore, be it proclaimed, by the Mayor and the Council of the Borough of Wenonah, the municipality expresses its most heartfelt thanks to Sarah Harbold for her contribution to the replanting and regrowth of Wenonah's trees following this major weather event; and

In Witness Whereof, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Seal of the Borough of Wenonah to be affixed this fifth day of January, 2023.

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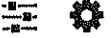
